Classy 82-13 Record Compiled By CFAW restlers

During its eight years of interscholastic wrestling competition Corning Free Academy grapplers racked up a classy record of 82 wins and 13 setbacks and in the process notched three West Central Conference championships.

Included in the 82 victories were one winning streak of 25 which was ended by Northside and the 35-match win skein which was halted this year by Horseheads.

For the past six seasons the Bulldogs have been coached by Joe Corcoran and over this period the Southside posted a 6-9 mark.

During the four-year history of the West Central Wrestling Conference, Corning Free Academy matmen won 26 while losing only one and won their last 22 conference matches in a row including three championships.

This year's club was sparked by Neal Pipe, a 180 pounder, who had a perfect record of 24 wins including his second sectional championship.
