

Mustang Grapplers Dominate Holiday Tourney

Five Capture Mat Trophies At Hornell Test

Dansville Central High School wrestlers won five of 12 events in the Holiday Tournament staged Saturday in Hornell and easily captured the team crown in competition with the area's top squads.

Bringing home trophies from the elimination tourney were Bruce Kenney (103-lb.), Gary Kreiley (112-lb.), Jim Brokaw (120-lb.), Jack Gillman (133-lb.) and Dave Sanderson (154-lb.).

In addition to Dansville and the host Hornell team, squads from Bath, Letchworth, Canisteo, Wallsville, Horseheads and Arcade competed in the mat features.

Two other DCHS grapplers won third place awards in consolation matches. Richard Pfuntner pinned D. Horping of Arcade in the 180-lb. match and Paul Walker pinned R. Wauflle of Canisteo in the 95-lb. division.

Kenney pinned Dave Peck of Bath in the first round and R. Partridge of Letchworth before scoring a decision over Jerry Andera of Arcade in the finals.

Kreiley pinned Jim Holden of Canisteo and downed Dick Rundell of Horseheads and then scored a 4-3 decision over Dick Coddington of Hornell in the championship round.

In winning his crown, Jim Brokaw posted an easy decision over Joe Bede of Arcade and a close decision over Don Mills of Horseheads to gain the finals. In the windup, Brokaw won 1-0 over Rudy Thompson of Bath.

Gillman had a comparatively easy time in capturing his title. He beat Jerry Beyea of Canisteo 7-0 in the first round, scored 6-2 over Martin Mucher of Letchworth in the second match and downed Jerry Gould of Horseheads 40 in the finals.

Sanderson pinned his first two opponents to gain the finals. He beat D. Lorow of Hornell in the first round and S. Moonschein of Horseheads in the second bout. In the finals, the Dansville wrestler posted a 3-0 decision over Pat
