PSUC To Host SUNY Wrestling Championship

The State University Conference wrestling championships will be held in Plattsburgh on Feb. 26, it was announced today (Nov. 4) by Don Lindell, coach of the Card grapplers.

The event will mark the first time in history that the Redbirds have hosted such a tournament.

Jack LaBombard, assistant to Lindell and a graduate student at PSUC, will be tournament director. Six full teams are expected to enter, with two other colleges sending partial teams.

The tourney will be held in the PSUC gym, beginning with weighins in the morning, and following with preliminary matches in the afternoon and the championship matches in the evening.

1965-66 wrestling schedule that this year includes the University of Buffalo and St. John Fisher College for the first time. The only team absent from the Card schedule of last winter is Hobart College.

Lindell also plans to send three and four of his top matmen to Cleveland on March 4-5 to wrestle in the 4-I Tournament.
