Gary Kreiley, 85-1 Wrestling Record

DANSVILLE — Gary Kreiley, of Dansville Central School's wrestling champion, has a record that must rate as one of the best in all of Section 5, the high school sports area that embraces some 120 schools in 11 counties.

In four years in the mat sport, Gary was beaten only once. He won 85 out of 86 bouts and included two sectional titles. He has 11 trophies and 4 medals in his collection.

His only defeat came in the sectional finals when he was a sophomore.

Gary started off at 112 pounds. He was 120 pounds as a sophomore; jumped to 138 as a junior and competed at 145 pounds this last season.

He never has had any weight problem. Most of the season he eats a normal diet. In other words, what ever has mother places on the table. He is extra careful the day of a bout.

So how did he get into wrestling? His brother, Herm, competed at Dansville and later at Alfred University. Gary decided this would be his sport.
