SYRACUSE - Union-Endicott, unbeaten in 54 consecutive dual matches, maintains the lead this week in the New York State Sportswriters Association wrestling poll.

Peru, who two years ago had a 122-match streak snapped by Cortland, has now won 150 duals while dropping two over the past 12 years.
