

Peru wrestlers jump to 4th

SYRACUSE — Union Endicott's unbeaten wrestlers notched two more dual victories this past week as they head a group of six streaking state mat powers in the New York State Scholastic Wrestling Ratings.

Among the talented sextet is Peru Central of Section 7. The unbeaten Indians, idle this past week following victory in their own 18-team tournament, slipped into the

fourth place as formerly No. 3 ranked Huntington was upset by Sonderling, 23-21.

Peru has won 26 straight dual matches (8-0 this year) and 152 of its last 154 matches.

Union Endicott, 11-0 this season, has won 57 straight mat duals while No. 2 rated Pioneer of Section 6 upped its record to 8-0 in 1974-75 and extended its dual win streak to 26 straight.

Section 3 powerhouse Baldwinsville is 13-0 and carries a 45 match win streak into this week's matches.

Mount Vernon, ranked sixth last week, slipped to eighth after tying with 20th-rated Suffern of Section 9, 24-24. Yet, the tie wasn't that devastating for Mount Vernon's ranking as injuries played an important role in the deadlock.

Brentwood Ross jumped from eighth to fifth in the poll.

Swim-a-thon nets \$1600

PLATTSBURGH — Officials of the Plattsburgh Swim Club called last Saturday's swim-a-thon "highly successful", reporting a net gain of approximately \$1,600 in pledges.

Sixty swimmers ranging in ages 8-45, participated with amounts ranging from a penny to five cents per pool length. Thirty swimmers went 200 pool lengths, or just 10 lengths shy of three miles.

Seventy per cent of the money raised goes to the local club with 20 per cent earmarked for the International Swimming Hall of Fame in Florida.

Five per cent will go to the National Swim-a-thon and five per cent to the local March of Dimes drive.

The Plattsburgh Swim Club will travel to Colonie Saturday to take part in the Hall of Fame meet.
