Brien's win keeps Bombers unbeaten

East Rochester led, 22-17, going into the last two matches but Steve Rosa, unbeaten for the Comets (5-2 overall, 5-2 league) decisioned Jeff Van Thof at 179 to give Rush-Henrietta a chance to win the meet with a decision at heavyweight.

Don St. James, also unbeaten for

Sperry, started the meet with a pin against Jeff Kier at four minutes, 21 seconds of the 100-pound bout.

East Rochester's Jack Connors decisioned Dan Miller, 6-3, at 107 pounds and John Benard of Sperry scored a 4-3 decision at 114. John Gueli of East Rochester then recorded the Bombers' only pin of the meet, over Ben Hornestein at 1:41 of the 121-pound bout to tie the score at 9-9.

Rush-Henrietta Sperry continued to put pressure on the Bombers, taking leads of 12-9 and 15-12 with decisions by Mike Miller and Sandy Spero at 128 and 140 pounds. Bob Petrone of East Rochester recorded a decision at 134.

Bob Steinruck, who along with Brien is unbeaten for East Rochester (9-0).

recorded a four-point decision, 11-3, over Tim Coraci at 147 to put the Bombers ahead, 16-15.

After the Bomberrs' John Antonelli and Mike Sacchitella drew, 4-4 at 157, John Zito of East Rochester scored a 15-4 decision against Dennis Carroll at 169 to give East Rochester four points and a 22-17 lead with two bouts left.
