The newcomers to the squad this year include juniors Doug Fogle (145), John Wheaton (160), and Austin Quinn (215), and eighth grader Jake Barnhart (215).

Leone views Rush-Henrietta, Fairport, and Greece Athena to be among the league contenders as well.
